What's the difference between a quote's MEANING and its SIGNIFICANCE?

# MEANING – WHAT THE QUOTATION IS ACTUALLY SAYING; THE INFO CONTAINED IN THE QUOTE

VS.

SIGNIFICANCE – THE IMPORTANCE; HOW OR WHY THE QUOTE IS IMPORTANT TO UNDERSTANDING THE PIECE OF LITERATURE

#### STEP 1:

Figure out who said the quote.

#### STEP 2:

## Determine where and when the quote was said.

-Knowing this information may help you do discover the significance.

#### STEP 3:

# Ask yourself some questions to help analyze the quote's significance.

- -Does the quote give you new information about the setting or events of the story that you weren't aware of before?
- -Does the quote tell you something about a character that you weren't aware of before?

### More questions...

- -Is the quote a moment in the story where the events or circumstances change? How does the quote relate to it?
- -Is the quote a moment in the story where a character's fate is determined?
- -Is the quote a moment in the story where a character is trying to do something very important? What is it? Why is the quote related to that?
- -How is the meaning of the quote important in the larger picture of the story?
