Holocaust Unit: Scrapbook Project (30 points)

People keep scrapbooks to remind them of the important people, places, and events of their lives. They often include some of the following: pictures of loved ones or favorite places, ticket stubs, small objects, favorite things, notes from friends, journal entries, poems, brochures, newspaper articles, badges, emblems, invitations, letters and announcements. People may include just about anything that is important to them and that can be glued in.

Your task is for each of you to create one scrapbook page on Explain Everything for the main character in your book. These “pages” will then be put together to form a whole “book” with your group. Real victims of the Holocaust probably would not be allowed to have such a book as they were often stripped of all personal possessions and even their names. So, imagine what such a book might include if it were the only thing your character was allowed to keep.

Each page must include the following: your name and class period, name and author of book, name of character, at least six different items with captions written from the character’s perspective. Since the scrapbook will be put together at the end of the project, you must work with your group to be sure that you all have different items to include on your scrapbook page. So, for example, if your group has three members, you each need to find six different things for the scrapbook, which means your group needs to help each other come up with a total of eighteen items.

The scrapbook must have an authentic looking front **cover** that includes the character’s name. Your group member’s names should be on the back of the scrapbook. Try to be creative to include many different types of materials.
